The ACM Europe Council <<http://europe.acm.org/>> and CECL <europe.acm.org/chapters.html> are pleased to announce a sponsored workshop of invited European ACM chapter leaders, hosted by **Czech Technical University (CTU)** of Prague. The purpose of this event is to strengthen ties within the European computing community, to provide tools for ACM Professional, SIGs and Student Chapters to be more effective, and to establish good communication between ACM and its chapter leaders. The sessions at this workshop will build on the findings reported in the previous edition, and the work that followed.

In this third edition, invited participants will have the opportunity to discuss a range of topics of relevance to them with other chapter leaders; meet key ACM people in person; explore and foster collaborations between chapters; learn about chapter best practices; listen to high-profile speakers from ACM Europe; interact with other leaders and ACM volunteers to work on the expansion and growth of our chapter network; and have a chance to work closely with CECL.

Our budget allows us to cover lodging for two nights and meals for 50 participants. Other expenses are to be covered by individual chapters. These 50 participants should represent the most active chapters in Europe, and will be selected according to a range of criteria, including the ACM annual report for 2015 and reported interest.
